

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Taliwa, Malitbog, Southern Leyte

as of 19 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 October 2024 at around 5:20 PM, a fire incident occurred at Ramon Vano St., Brgy. Taliwa, Malitbog, Southern Leyte.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Taliwa, Malitbog, Southern Leyte**. (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There is **one (1) family** or **five (5) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Taliwa, Malitbog, Southern Leyte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱18,031.50** worth of assistance from **DSWD** was provided to the affected families (see Annex D).
