

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incident in Tantangan, South Cotabato

as of 03 December 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 02 December 2024 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms may have brought possible flash flood or landslides during severe thunderstorm to some areas in the country. On the same day, Brgy. Cabuling, Bukay Pait, New Lambunao, and Maibo experienced a flash flood incident due to localized thunderstorms.
