

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat

as of 13 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 09 December 2024, cloudy skies with scattered rains and isolated thunderstorms caused by the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) may have caused flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Visayas, Mindanao and Palawan. On the same day, several barangays in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat experienced flooding due to ITCZ.

A total of **771 families** or **3,039 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat** (see Annex A).
