

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incidents in Eastern Visayas

as of 23 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 23 December 2024 at 4:00 AM, cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms due to Shear Line may have caused possible flashfloods or landslides due to moderate to heavy with at times intense rains in Visayas, Bicol Region, CALABARZON, and the rest of MIMAROPA.

On the same day, several barangays in the provinces of Eastern Samar and Northern Samar experienced flooding due to Shear Line.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,958 families** or **11,200 persons** are affected in **15 barangays** in **Eastern Visayas** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **29 families** or **124 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **eight (8) evacuation centers** in **Eastern Visayas** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **10 families** or **30 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **39 families** or **154 persons** displaced in **Eastern Visayas** (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 270,507 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 127,037 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 143,470 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 81,036 FFPs available at DSWD FO VIII.
- ₱72.04 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VIII warehouses.
