

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Easterlies in Mindanao

as of 31 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 December 2024, heavy rainfall brought by the Easterlies resulted in flash flood and landslide incidents in Brgy. Pamantingan, Esperanza, Sultan Kudarat. On the same day, Brgy. Madaum in Tagum City also experienced flooding and landslides due to heavy rains brought by the Easterlies.

On 13 December 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a whirlwind incident occurred in Brgy. Usugan, Bonifacio, Misamis Occidental that resulted in several damaged houses.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 322 families or 1,321 persons are affected in three (3) barangays in Regions X, XII and XII (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are seven (7) families or 35 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Brgy. Pamantingan Gym in Brgy. Pamantingan, Ezperanza, Sultan Kudarat (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are seven (7) families or 30 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **14 families** or **65 persons** still displaced in **Regions X** and **XII** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 29 houses were damaged; of which, are 14 totally damaged and 15 are partially damaged in Regions X and XII (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}\$18,360.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}\$158,360.00 from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}\$160,000.00 from a Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱2.12 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱9 million available at DSWD FO X, XI and XII.
- ₱38 million available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the affected families.
