

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Mindanao

as of 02 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 December 2024, several barangays in the municipality of Dipolog City, Zamboanga del Norte experienced heavy rainfall and flooding due to ITCZ.

On 09 December 2024, the municipality of Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat also reported several flooding incidents brought by the ITCZ.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,429 families** or **6,329 persons** are affected in **five (5) barangays** in **Regions IX** and **XII** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **658 families** or **3,290 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱551,265.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
