## I. Situation Overview

On 11 December 2024 at around 7:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 19 College Park, Musuan, Brgy. Dologon, Maramag, Bukidnon. The fire was declared out at around 9:35 AM.

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Dologon, Maramag, Bukidnon (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P281,251.65** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **P213,383.00** from **DSWD** and **P67,868.65** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
