

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flooding Incidents in Cagayan as of 29 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 27 December 2024 at 4:00 AM, cloudy skies with rains caused by the Northeast Monsoon may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains over the Cagayan Valley, Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR), and Ilocos Norte. On the same day, several barangays in the municipalities of Baggao, Lal-lo, and Lasam in the province of Cagayan, experienced flooding due to the Northeast Monsoon.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **414 families** or **1,305 persons** are affected in **10 barangays** in **Cagayan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **seven (7) families** or **15 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Cabayu Barangay Hall** in **Ballesteros, Cagayan** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱235,623.64** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
