

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on Tropical Depression "Romina"

as of 27 December 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview


On 22 December 2024 at 10:00 AM, Tropical Depression "Romina" moved North Northeastward towards the Southern Kalayaan Islands. On the same day, at 2:00 PM, it maintained its strength while moving Northward towards the Southern Kalayaan Islands. At 7:00 PM, it was observed to be at the western portion of Kalayaan Islands, and by 11:00 PM, it continued to move northwestward over the West of Kalayaan Islands.

On 23 December 2024 at 5:00 AM, Tropical Depression "Romina" continued to move Northwestward and was no longer directly affecting Kalayaan Islands.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 15,205 families or 74,068 persons are affected in 73 barangays in MIMAROPA (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **444 families** or **1,723 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **12 evacuation centers** in **MIMAROPA** (see Annex B).



b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **423 families** or **1,650 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **867 families** or **3,373 persons** still displaced in **MIMAROPA** (see Annex D).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱1,779,800.00 worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱2.21 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱3 million available at DSWD FO MIMAROPA.
- ₱44 million available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by Tropical Depression (TD) "Romina" through inter-FO augmentation.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 228,607 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 140,437 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 88,170 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 92,919 FFPs available at DSWD FO MIMAROPA.
- 1,184,700 FFPs in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the effects of TD "Romina" through inter-FO augmentation.
- ₱896.60 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO warehouses.
