

DSWD DROMIC Report #5 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Mindanao

as of 30 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview


On 25 December 2024, several barangays in the municipalities of Malita and Don Marcelino in Davao Occidental experienced flooding and landslides due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the ITCZ.

On 26 December 2024, flash flood incidents were experienced in several municipalities in the provinces of Sarangani and Sultan Kudarat due to continuous heavy rains caused by ITCZ.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **9,621 families** or **42,749 persons** are affected in **64 barangays** in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **977 families** or **4,176 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **16 evacuation centers** in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex B).



b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **55 families** or **258 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 1,032 families or 4,434 persons still displaced in Regions XI and XII (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 665 houses were damaged; of which, 277 are totally damaged and 388 are partially damaged in Regions XI and XII (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱3,878,420.00 worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex G).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱2.21 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱6 million available at DSWD FOs XI and XII.
- ₱41 million available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the ITCZ through inter-FO augmentation.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 342,247 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 207,037 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 135,210 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 220,461 FFPs available at DSWD FOs XI and XII.
- 1,041,494 FFPs available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the ITCZ through inter-FO augmentation.
