

# DSWD DROMIC Report #7 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Mindanao

as of 01 January 2025, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

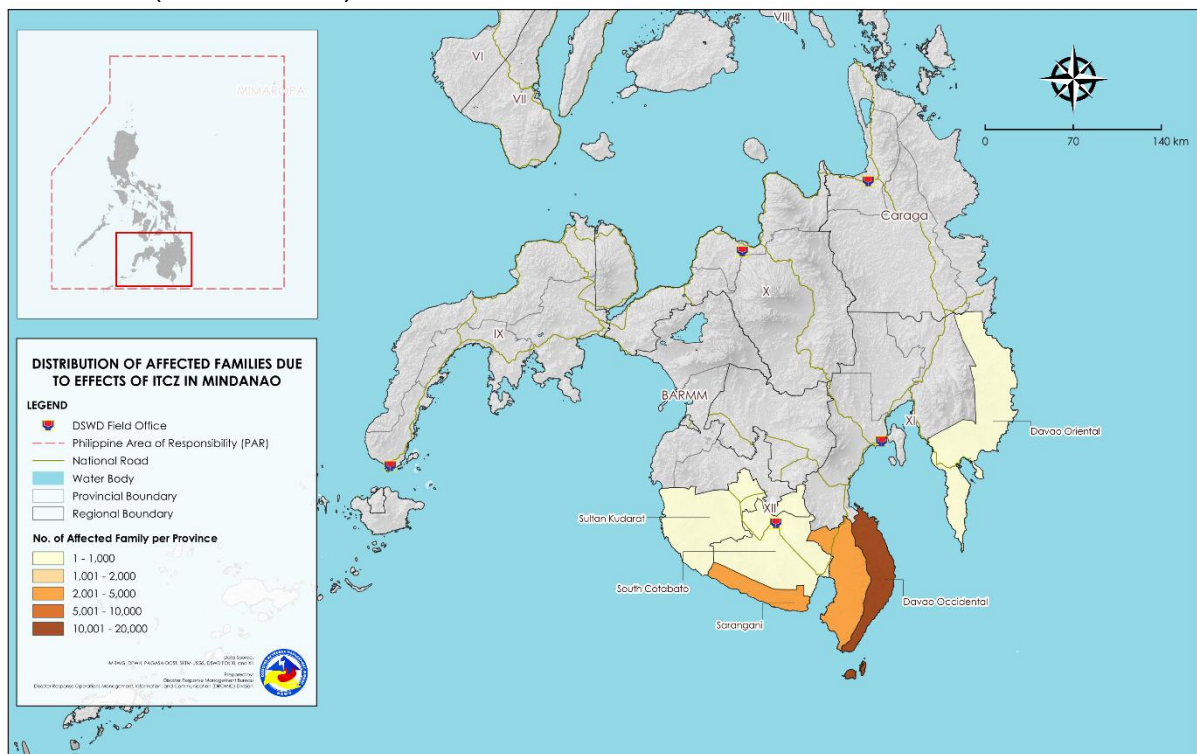
On 25 December 2024, several barangays in the municipalities of Malita and Don Marcelino in Davao Occidental experienced flooding and landslides due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the ITCZ.

On 26 December 2024, flash flood incidents were experienced in several municipalities in the provinces of Sarangani and Sultan Kudarat due to continuous heavy rains caused by ITCZ.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **19,461 families** or **84,481 persons** are affected in **80 barangays** in **Regions XI and XII** (see Annex A).



## III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **831 families** or **3,560 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **14 evacuation centers** in **Regions XI and XII** (see Annex B).

**b. Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **400 families** or **2,000 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

**c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **1,231 families** or **5,560 persons** still displaced in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex E).

**IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **1,179 houses** were damaged; of which, **422** are **totally damaged** and **757** are **partially damaged** in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex F).

**V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱6,590,186.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex G).

**1. Standby Funds**
