

DSWD DROMIC Report #7 on the Effects of Shear Line

as of 09 December 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview


On 01 December 2024, several municipalities in the provinces of Capiz and Aklan in Western Visayas and municipalities in the provinces of Albay, Camarines Norte, Camarines Sur, and Catanduanes in the Bicol Region experienced incidents of flooding and landslides due to the effects of Shear Line.

On 02 December 2024, incidents of flooding, landslides, and other incidents related to the effects of Shear Line were reported in Cebu City.

On 04 December 2024, the effects of Shear Line was reported in Tuguegarao City. Source: DOST-PAGASA Daily Weather Bulletin and DSWD Field Offices (FOs)

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **27,880 families** or **111,891 persons** are affected in **300 barangays** in **Regions II**, V, VI and VII (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **641 families** or **2,326 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **23 evacuation centers** in **Regions II**, **V**, and **VI** (see Annex B).



b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **22 families** or **80 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **663 families** or **2,406 persons** still displaced in **Regions II**, **V**, **VI**, and **VII** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **49 houses** were damaged; of which,**13** are **totally damaged** and **36** are **partially damaged** in **Regions V**, **VII** and **VII** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱3,575,483.89 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱2,531,983.89 from DSWD and ₱1,043,500.00 from the Local Government Units (LGUs) (see Annex F).
