

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Easterlies in Mindanao

26 February 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 11 December 2024, heavy rainfall brought by the Easterlies resulted in flash flood and landslide incidents in Brgy. Pamantingan, Esperanza, Sultan Kudarat. On the same day, Brgy. Madaum in Tagum City also experienced flooding and landslides due to heavy rains brought by the Easterlies.

On 13 December 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a whirlwind incident occurred in Brgy. Usugan, Bonifacio, Misamis Occidental that resulted in several damaged houses.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **322 families** or **1,321 persons** were affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Regions X, XII and XII** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **seven (7) families** or **35 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Pamantingan Gym** in **Brgy. Pamantingan, Ezperanza, Sultan Kudarat** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **five (5) families** or **20 persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **five (5) families** or **20 persons** still displaced in **Region X** (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **29 houses** were damaged; of which, **14 are totally damaged** and **15 are partially damaged** in **Regions X and XII** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱318,360.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱158,360.00** from **DSWD** and **₱160,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
