

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Armyworm in San Francisco, Cebu

as of 04 February 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 June 2024, a fall armyworm infestation was reported in Brgy. Consuclo and Brgy. Southern Poblacion in San Francisco, Cebu. Subsequently, 13 other barangays were reported to have experienced widespread armyworm infestations, which resulted in substantial damage and loss of livelihood among the farmers in the municipality.

A total of **7,115 persons** are affected in **15 barangays** in **San Francisco, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱4,378,464.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected persons (see Annex B).
