

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident at Baguio City Public Market in Brgy. Kayang-Hilltop, Baguio City as of 09 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 December 2024 at around 9:32 PM, a fire incident occurred at Baguio City Public Market in Block 4, Brgy. Kayang-Hilltop, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 10:00 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **eight (8) stall owners** or **vendors** are affected in **Brgy. Kayang-Hilltop, Baguio City** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱62,112.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected stall owners or vendors; of which, **₱14,112.00** from **DSWD** and **₱48,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex B).
