

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 46, Tondo, Manila City

as of 16 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 January 2025 at around 2:07 PM, a fire incident occurred at C.P. Garcia St., Brgy. 46, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 3:15 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 124 families or 464 persons are affected in Brgy. 46, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 46 families or 184 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Brgy. Covered Court in Brgy. 46, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **78 families** or **280 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 124 families or 464 persons still displaced in Brgy. 46, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **29 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 46**, **Tondo**, **Manila City** (see Annex E).

- 277,448 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 292,280 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 135,168 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 61,494 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱75.59 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
