

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 458, Sampaloc, Manila City as of 17 January 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 16 January 2025 at around 5:08 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sulucan St., Brgy. 458, Sampaloc, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 6:58 AM.
