On 29 January 2025 at around 1:29 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 1, Brgy. BGH Compound, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 2:29 PM.

There are seven (7) families or 27 persons currently taking temporary shelter in CDRRMO Evacuation Center in Brgy. BGH, Baguio City (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of two (2) houses are totally damaged in Brgy. BGH, Baguio City (see Annex E).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱153,823.36 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱71,473.36 from DSWD, ₱73,100.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) and ₱9,250.00 from Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) (see Annex F).
