

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Camp 4, Tuba, Benguet as of 02 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 January 2025 at around 1:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Camp 6, Brgy. Camp 4, Tuba, Benguet. The fire was declared out at around 6:30 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **62 families** or **159 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Camp 4, Tuba, Benguet** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **62 families** or **159 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **31 houses** were damaged; of which, **27** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Camp 4, Tuba, Benguet** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱694,806.75** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
