

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Crossing Bayabas, Davao City

as of 22 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 January 2025 at around 3:05 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 12-Saint Matthew Corner Saint Paul Crossing, Brgy. Crossing Bayabas, Davao City. The fire was declared out at around 4:41 PM.

In response to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office in Region XI, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

A total of **27 families** or **93 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Crossing Bayabas, Davao City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **27 families** or **93 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Crossing Bayabas Gym** in **Davao City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **27 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Crossing Bayabas**, **Davao City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱244,377.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
