

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Duljo Fatima, Cebu City

as of 07 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 January 2025, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Lower Galili, Brgy. Duljo Fatima, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 4:31 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **74 families** or **283 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Duljo Fatima**, **Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 13 families or 72 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Duljo Fatima Brgy. Hall in Cebu City (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **61 families** or **211 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **74 families** or **283 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Duljo Fatima**, **Cebu City** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 33 houses were damaged; of which, 30 are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Duljo Fatima, Cebu City (see Annex F).

1. Standby Funds

• ₱3.30 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 341,422 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 156,302 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 185,120 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 81,211 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱170.32 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.

b. Other Activities

05 January 2025	 DSWD FO XII maintained close coordination with the LGU of Cebu City and other concerned offices for significant updates and any requests for augmentation. DSWD FO VII referred the affected families to the Crisis Intervention Section for further assessment and provision of financial assistance through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS).
