

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Duljo Fatima, Cebu City as of 07 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 January 2025, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Lower Galili, Brgy. Duljo Fatima, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 4:31 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **74 families** or **283 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Duljo Fatima, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **13 families** or **72 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Duljo Fatima Brgy. Hall** in **Cebu City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **61 families** or **211 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **74 families** or **283 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Duljo Fatima, Cebu City** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **33 houses** were damaged; of which, **30** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Duljo Fatima, Cebu City** (see Annex F).
