I. Situation Overview

On 19 January 2025 at around 7:54 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Iringan, Allacapan, Cagayan.

A total of three (3) families or six (6) persons are affected in Brgy. Iringan, Allacapan, Cagayan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are three (3) families or six (6) persons temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was partially damaged in Brgy. Iringan, Allacapan, Cagayan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P20,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 261,977 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 108,477 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 153,500 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 84,584 FFPs available at DSWD FO II.
- ₱130.58 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO II warehouses.
