I. Situation Overview

On 15 January 2025 at around 1:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Manga 1, Brgy. Libertad Bajo, Sinacaban, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 1:13 PM.

A total of two (2) families or seven (7) persons are affected in Brgy. Libertad Bajo, Sinacaban, Misamis Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are two (2) families or seven (7) persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of two (2) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Libertad Bajo, Sinacaban, Misamis Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P19,336.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **P15,836.00** from **DSWD** and **P3,500.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
