I. Situation Overview

On 12 December 2024 at around 3:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Lubon, Tadian, Mountain Province. The fire was declared out at around 4:00 PM.

A total of two (2) families or eight (8) persons are affected in Brgy. Lubon, Tadian, Mountain Province (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are two (2) families or eight (8) persons temporarily staying with their friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of two (2) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Lubon, Tadian, Mountain Province (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P40,432.65** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
