

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Maputi, Naawan, Misamis Oriental

as of 14 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 January 2025 at around 5:00 AM, a fire occurred in Brgy. Maputi, Naawan, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 06:15AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of four (4) families or 15 persons are affected in Brgy. Maputi, Naawan, Misamis Oriental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are two (2) families or six (6) persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of four (4) houses were damaged; of which, two (2) are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Maputi, Naawan, Misamis Oriental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}84,644.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of \$\mathbb{P}38,644.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}46,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
