

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Masla, Tadian, Mountain Province

as of 25 January 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 09 January 2025 at around 3:55 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Galwa, Brgy. Masla, Tadian, Mt. Province. The fire was declared out at around 4:22 PM.

**One (1) family** or **six (6) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Masla, Tadian, Mountain Province** (see Annex A).

**One (1) house** was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Masla, Tadian, Mountain Province** (see Annex B).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱26,281.60** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱12,394.60** from **DSWD** and **₱13,887.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
