

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Masla, Tadian, Mountain Province

as of 25 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 09 January 2025 at around 3:55 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Galwa, Brgy. Masla, Tadian, Mt. Province. The fire was declared out at around 4:22 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or six (6) persons are affected in Brgy. Masla, Tadian, Mountain Province (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was partially damaged in Brgy. Masla, Tadian, Mountain Province (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}26,281.60\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, \$\mathbb{P}12,394.60\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}13,887.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex C).
