

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mobod, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental

as of 10 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 31 December 2024 at around 6:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 6, Brgy. Mobod, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 7:15 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **six (6) families** or **22 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Mobod, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **six (6) families** or **22 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **six (6) houses** were damaged; of which, **five (5)** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Mobod, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱78,172.48** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱50,172.48** from **DSWD** and **₱28,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
