

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mobod, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental

as of 10 January 2025, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 31 December 2024 at around 6:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 6, Brgy. Mobod, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 7:15 AM.

A total of six (6) families or 22 persons are affected in Brgy. Mobod, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

There are six (6) families or 22 persons temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were damaged; of which, five (5) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Mobod, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P78,172.48** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **P50,172.48** from **DSWD** and **P28,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex D).
