

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Osmeña, Marabut, Western Samar as of 24 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 December 2025, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Osmeña, Marabut, Western Samar, resulting in the displacement of a family, who is taking temporary shelter with their relatives.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Osmeña, Marabut, Western Samar** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Osmeña, Marabut, Western Samar** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱18,970.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱6,970.00** from **DSWD** and **₱12,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
