

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pajo, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu

as of 25 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 January 2025 at around 1:32 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Pajo, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 2:58 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **59 families** or **275 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Pajo, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **59 families** or **275 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Pajo, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **44 houses** were damaged; of which, **41** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Pajo, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu** (see Annex C).
