

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Sulop, Davao del Sur

as of 14 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 January 2025 at around 10:45 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 3 Brgy. Poblacion, Sulop, Davao del Sur.

In response to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office in Region XI, promptly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

A total of five (5) families or 19 persons are affected in Brgy. Poblacion, Sulop, Davao del Sur (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are five (5) families or 19 persons currently taking temporary shelter at **Purok 9 Poblacion Evacuation Center** in **Sulop**, **Davao del Sur** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of five (5) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Poblacion, Sulop, Davao del Sur (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱7,150.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
