

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Rizal Lapuz Sur, Lapuz, Iloilo City as of 09 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 January 2025 at around 1:05 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Rizal Lapuz Sur, Lapuz, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 1:47 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **43 families** or **168 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Rizal Lapuz Sur, Lapuz, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **43 families** or **168 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Jalandoni Memorial Elementary School** in **Brgy. Rizal Lapuz Sur, Lapuz, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **17 houses** were damaged; of which, **16** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Rizal Lapuz Sur, Lapuz, Iloilo City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱220,046.80** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱113,972.00** from **DSWD** and **₱106,074.80** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
