

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Rizal Lapuz Sur, Lapuz, Iloilo City

as of 09 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 January 2025 at around 1:05 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Rizal Lapuz Sur, Lapuz, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 1:47 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 43 families or 168 persons are affected in Brgy. Rizal Lapuz Sur, Lapuz, Iloilo City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 43 families or 168 persons currently taking temporary shelter at Jalandoni Memorial Elementary School in Brgy. Rizal Lapuz Sur, Lapuz, Iloilo City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 17 houses were damaged; of which, 16 are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Rizal Lapuz Sur, Lapuz, Iloilo City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱220,046.80 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱113,972.00 from DSWD and ₱106,074.80 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
