

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Rosario, Pasig City as of 22 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 January 2025 at around 7:04 PM, a fire incident occurred at West Bank Road Floodway, Brgy. Rosario, Pasig City. The fire was declared out at around 8:46 PM.

A total of **70 families** or **210 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Rosario, Pasig City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **70 families** or **210 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Hunter Evacuation Center** in **Brgy. Rosario, Pasig City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **28 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Rosario, Pasig City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱185,280.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
