

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Taboc Sur, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental as of 31 January 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 27 January 2025 at around 1:08 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Taboc Sur, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 1:45 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **six (6) families** or **16 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Taboc, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

There are **six (6) families** or **16 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **six (6) houses** were damaged; of which, **two (2)** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Taboc, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱57,372.48** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱50,172.48** from **DSWD** and **₱7,200.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
