

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Taboc Sur, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental

I. Situation Overview

On 27 January 2025 at around 1:08 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Taboc Sur, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 1:45 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of six (6) families or 16 persons are affected in Brgy. Taboc, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **six (6) families** or **16 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were damaged; of which, two (2) are totally damaged and four (4) are partially damaged in Brgy. Taboc, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P57,372.48** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **P50,172.48** from **DSWD** and **P7,200.00** from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex D).
