

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City as of 07 January 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 January 2025 at around 7:04 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 7:55 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **30 families** or **115 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **30 families** or **115 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Hall** in **Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **29 houses** were damaged; of which, **24** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱50,040.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
