

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tambacan, Iligan City as of 18 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 30 December 2024 at around 2:31 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tambacan, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte. The fire was declared out at around 4:14 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **24 families** or **92 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tambacan, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **24 families** or **92 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** were damaged; of which, **eight (8)** are **totally damaged** and **seven (7)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Tambacan, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱112,352.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱88,592.00** from **DSWD** and **₱23,760.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
