as of 18 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 January 2025 at around 5:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Zapote I, City of Bacoor, Cavite. The fire was declared out at around 6:00 AM.

A total of **315 families** or **1,575 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Zapote I, City of Bacoor, Cavite** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **315 families or 1,575 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Zapote I Covered Court** in **City of Bacoor, Cavite** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P434,070.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
