

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Cavite

as of 26 December 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 December 2024 at around 5:05 AM, a fire incident occurred within the adjacent areas of Brgy. Pag-asa, Imus City, and Brgy. Gahak and Marulas, Kawit City. The fire was declared out at around 7:00 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **111 families** or **376 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Cavite** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **102 families** or **355 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Cavite** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **nine (9) families** or **21 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **111 families** or **376 persons** displaced in **Cavite** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **18 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Cavite** (see Annex E).
