

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incidents in SOCCSKSARGEN

as of 09 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 January 2025 at around 6:19 PM, heavy rains brought by localized thunderstorms caused a flash flood in seven (7) low-lying barangays in Koronadal City, South Cotabato. By 08 January 2025 at around 3 AM, the same weather conditions triggered another flash flood in several barangays in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,534 families** or **6,531 persons** are affected in **nine (9) barangays** in **Region XII** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **five (5) families** or **25 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Barangay Morales Evacuation Center** in **Koronadal City, South Cotabato** (see Annex B).
