

# **DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the** Flash Flood Incidents in SOCCSKSARGEN

as of 09 January 2025, 6AM

#### **Situation Overview** I.

On 07 January 2025 at around 6:19 PM, heavy rains brought by localized thunderstorms caused a flash flood in seven (7) low-lying barangays in Koronadal City, South Cotabato. By 08 January 2025 at around 3 AM, the same weather conditions triggered another flash flood in several barangays in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat.

#### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 1,534 families or 6,531 persons are affected in nine (9) barangays in Region XII (see Annex A).

### Inside Evacuation Center

A total of five (5) families or 25 persons sought temporary shelter at the Barangay Morales Evacuation Center in Koronadal City, South Cotabato (see Annex B).
