

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incidents in Davao City as of 06 January 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 04 January 2025 at around 6:00 PM, a flooding incident caused by heavy rainfall brought about by localized thunderstorms was experienced in a river at Brgy. 74-A Matina Crossing, Davao City. The flooding incident resulted in impassable roads and heightened risk to residents in low-lying and flood-prone areas in Brgy. Matina Aplaya, Brgy. Matina Crossing and Brgy. Matina Pangi.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **617 families** or **2,211 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Davao City** (see Annex A).

A total of **20 houses** were damaged; of which, **15** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Davao City** (see Annex B).
