

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incidents in Palawan

as of 15 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 13 January 2025, 4:00 PM, cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms caused by Easterlies that may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Palawan.

On the same day, municipalities of Sofronio Española and Brooke's Point in Palawan experienced flooding due to heavy rains brought by Easterlies.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 134 families or 515 persons are affected in six (6) barangays in Palawan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 123 families or 460 persons currently taking temporary shelter in six (6) evacuation centers in Palawan (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are 11 families or 55 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 134 families or 515 persons still displaced in Palawan (see Annex D).

- 274,848 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 123,180 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 151,668 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 99,500 FFPs available at DSWD FO MIMAROPA.
- ₱96.58 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO MIMAROPA warehouses.
