

DSWD DROMIC Report #10 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Mindanao

as of 03 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview


On 25 December 2024, several barangays in the municipalities of Malita and Don Marcelino in Davao Occidental experienced flooding and landslides due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the ITCZ.

On 26 December 2024, flash flood incidents were experienced in several municipalities in the provinces of Sarangani and Sultan Kudarat due to continuous heavy rains caused by ITCZ.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 28,284 families or 127,220 persons are affected in 92 barangays in Regions XI and XII (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of 836 families or 3,553 persons currently taking temporary shelter in 14 evacuation centers in Regions XI and XII (see Annex B).



b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **403 families** or **2,015 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 1,239 families or 5,568 persons still displaced in Regions XI and XII (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 1,184 houses were damaged; of which, 423 are totally damaged and 761 are partially damaged in Regions XI and XII (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P12,915,076.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex G).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱1.91 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱6 million available at DSWD FOs XI and XII.
- ₱41 million available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the ITCZ through inter-FO augmentation.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 319,698 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 177,135 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 142,563 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 212,707 FFPs available at DSWD FOs XI and XII.
- 1,061,670 FFPs available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the ITCZ through inter-FO augmentation.
- ₱967.62 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, DSWD FO XI and FO XII warehouses.
