

DSWD DROMIC Report #11 on the Effects of Shear Line

as of 22 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview


Issued on 08 January 2025 at 4AM, cloudy skies with scattered rains and isolated thunderstorms caused by Shear Line that may have caused possible flash floods or landslides in Visayas, Bicol Region, Quezon, Marinduque, Romblon, and Dinagat Islands.

On the same day, various areas in the provinces of Albay, Sorosogon, Camarines Sur, and Catanduanes experienced intense heavy rainfall and widespread flooding. Moreover, due to continuous heavy rainfall caused by the Shear Line, several flooding and landslide incidents were reported in low-lying barangays in Cadiz City, Negros Occidental including parts of Eastern Samar and Northern Samar.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **188,825 families** or **774,421 persons** are affected in **802 barangays** in **Regions V**, **VI**, and **VIII** (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **15 families** or **41 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **one (1)** evacuation center in Regions V and VI (see Annex B).



b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **6,607 families** or **25,235 persons** sought temporarily shelter with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **15 families** or **41 persons** still displaced in **Regions V** and **VI** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of two (2) houses were damaged; of which, one (1) is totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Regions V (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱40,652,851.21 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱40,323,351.21 from DSWD and ₱329,500.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 261,977 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 108,477 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 153,500 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.

	 The DRMB works in close partnership with the Department of Science and Technology - Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (DOST-PAGASA) to obtain significant weather updates and related information regarding the Shear Line's effects. The DRMB, through the DSWD Disaster Response Command Center (DRCC), closely coordinates with the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) and other concerned offices for significant updates and other related information regarding the effects of Shear Line. The National Resource and Logistics Management Bureau (NRLMB) ensures the replenishment and availability of FNIs for resource augmentation to DSWD FOs as need arises.
