

# DSWD DROMIC Report #13 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Mindanao

as of 08 January 2025, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview


On 25 December 2024, several barangays in the municipalities of Malita and Don Marcelino in Davao Occidental experienced flooding and landslides due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the ITCZ.

On 26 December 2024, flash flood incidents were experienced in several municipalities in the provinces of Sarangani and Sultan Kudarat due to continuous heavy rains caused by ITCZ.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 30,565 families or 138,087 persons are affected in 97 barangays in Regions XI and XII (see Annex A).



# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **808 families** or **3,493 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **13 evacuation centers** in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex B).



#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **404 families** or **2,020 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **1,212 families** or **5,513 persons** still displaced in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex E).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 1,189 houses were damaged; of which, 427 are totally damaged and 762 are partially damaged in Regions XI and XII (see Annex F).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P23,678,944.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex G).

#### 1. Standby Funds

- ₱3.3 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱6 million available at DSWD FOs XI and XII.
- \$\mathbb{P}\$38 million available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the ITCZ through inter-FO augmentation.

#### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 354,160 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 154,510 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 199,650 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 197,372 FFPs available at DSWD FOs XI and XII.
- 1,285,335 FFPs available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the ITCZ through inter-FO augmentation.
