

DSWD DROMIC Report #16 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Mindanao

as of 14 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview


On 25 December 2024, several barangays in the municipalities of Malita and Don Marcelino in Davao Occidental experienced flooding and landslides due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the ITCZ.

On 26 December 2024, flash flood incidents were experienced in several municipalities in the provinces of Sarangani and Sultan Kudarat due to continuous heavy rains caused by ITCZ.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **33,872 families** or **154,627 persons** are affected in **103 barangays** in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center
 A total of 808 families or 3,493 persons currently taking temporary shelter in 13 evacuation centers in Regions XI and XII (see Annex B).



b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **404 families** or **2,020 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 1,212 families or 5,513 persons still displaced in Regions XI and XII (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 1,219 houses were damaged; of which, 444 are totally damaged and 775 are partially damaged in Regions XI and XII (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}27,223,193.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which by \$\mathbb{P}27,192,693.00\$ from \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}30,500.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex G).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items
